INTRODUCTION

All Tourism Operators in Vanuatu must be a member of a recognised Tourism Association. This is very important, as you will need to go through your association to obtain your Tourism Permit. Without a Tourism Permit you will not be able to obtain a Business Licence, and as such, cannot operate a business.

Joining an association is easy, simply contact one of the associations listed below. Each association targets a slightly different Tourism Sector, so feel free to take your time, investigate, and ensure that you are joining an association that is a good fit for you and your business.
