**IMMIGRATION (FEES) REGULATION**

Order 46 of 2005

**To prescribe certain fees for the purposes of the Immigration Act [Cap. 66].**

**1. Fees**

The various fees set out in Column B shall be payable, on application, by the applicant to the Principal Immigration Officer for the various matters set out under Column A.

<b>(e) The replacement or alteration of a permit or change of immigration status</b>	10,000
<b>(f) The preparation of any other certificate or document</b>	5,000
<b>(g) Yacht Immigration Clearance (per person)</b>	2,000
<b>(h) A permit to enter and reside in Vanuatu for one year for those engaged in full time study</b>	10,000
<b>(i) An extension of a permit to reside in Vanuatu for one year for those engaged in full time study</b>	10,000
<b>(j) A permit to enter and reside in Vanuatu for one year for those 55 years of age or over and who do not hold either a current work permit or current business licence</b>	30,000
<b>(k) An extension of a permit to reside in Vanuatu for one year for those 55 years of age or over and who do not hold either a current work permit or current business licence</b>	30,000
