

Accreditation & Compliance



- It is compulsory for all registered tourism businesses to gain accreditation against these Guidelines
- It will become part of the Tourism Permit process
- Two ways that businesses can gain accreditation:
 - Self-Verification
 - Assessment
- Accreditation – recognition that Operators have met the standards required to be a COVID Safe business.



Self-Verification



Appoint a staff member to be responsible for Covid Safety in your workplace

Your appointed staff member (and other staff) to attend Covid Safe Train-the-trainer training to be delivered by a registered training provider

Deliver your own Covid-Safe training in your workplace

When you are satisfied that all your staff are trained to be Covid-Safe, the business owner to log onto the [DoT website](#) to undertake self-verification

Once you have logged on, you will be asked a series of questions about COVID Safety in your workplace and will be asked to upload some documents

If you answer YES to all the questions and have uploaded the required documents, you have gained accreditation through the self-verification process

Covid-Safe collateral will be issued to you (Triple 'C' logo, posters) which you can display in your workplace



Assessment

Appoint a staff member to be responsible for COVID Safety in your workplace

Manager/owner, your appointed staff member and 50% of staff to attend COVID Safe training to be delivered by a registered training provider

During the training you will be assessed by the trainer to see if you and your staff have achieved competency

If you have achieved competency, then the trainer will advise the Government Department responsible to complete a workplace audit


Once your business passes the audit, Covid-Safe collateral will be issued to you (Triple 'C' logo, posters) which you can display in your workplace



Clean, Caring, Checked – The 3 C's



- An accredited business will be issued collateral [logo, poster, stickers] that you can use to show your customers that you are a COVID-Safe business, committed to keeping your employees and customers safe.
- Clean, Caring, Checked






Audits & Spot Checks



- After gaining accreditation, businesses will be subject to spot checks and audits by 'Improvement Officers'.
- To ensure businesses remain compliant with SBO Guidelines
- Non-Compliance will be addressed through facilitation over a period of time to remedy the condition[s]
